
A: REMOVAL

1) Disconnect the ground cable from battery. <Ref. to NT-5, BATTERY, NOTE, Note.>


NOTF:

For the 12 volt engine restart battery, disconnect the ground terminal from 12V engine restart battery sensor.

- 2) Lift up the vehicle.
- 3) Remove the clips, and turn over the front side of the mud guard front.



- 4) Remove the pedestrian alert speaker.
 - (1) Disconnect the connector.
 - (2) Remove the bolt, and remove the pedestrian alert speaker and bracket as a unit.



(3) Remove the keyless buzzer from bracket.

B: INSTALLATION

Install each part in the reverse order of removal.

Tightening torque:

Pedestrian alert speaker: 7.5 N·m (0.76 kgf-m, 5.5 ft-lb)

C: INSPECTION

Using the Subaru Select Monitor, perform the compulsory sound generation of the speaker. <Ref. to PA(diag)-12, System Operation Check Mode.>
